Cottonwood guidelines for a "Perfect Fit" appliance:

- ➤ Aim for a 10mm base on all working models (1/2 inch.) *We charge for pouring a base*
- ➤ If sending impressions, use "5 day" alginate.
- Wrap impressions with damp paper towel, and no standing water in the bag.
- ➤ Make certain that impressions are complete:
 - Entire palate and teeth necessary for appliance.
 - Preferably, entire arch and all of its teeth, with apparent sulci.
 - Tray should not be visible through the impression material.
 - Have doctors check impressions.
 - Please **NO** triple tray impressions.
- ➤ If sending models, no air bubbles please, always use a Whip Mixer when possible.
- For working models, pour in stone, not plaster standard laboratory practice.

*Note that Cottonwood's Perfect Fit quidelines must be observed in order to enjoy the quarantee. *

More tips from professionals like you:

- ➤ Keep consistent measurements when mixing alginate, plaster and stone.
- ➤ Think, is the impression ready to pull? Count 10-15 more seconds before releasing.
- Release suction, or "unlock" back impression with finger before withdrawing the tray. Pull tray out quickly, in an occlusal direction.
- Watch stone consistency (not too thick or thin).

In the event of an ill-fitting appliance, simply return the appliance, along with its corresponding model, new impression and new Rx form, and we'll remake it at no additional cost. *Conditions Apply*
